



It's time to farewell the 2020 Bowling Year. Many would say that it can't come quick enough but we are able to recall the start of the year when we were on a high after winning the men's top grade

2021 Pennants

The 2021 Pennant season is only just around the corner. The first game for the men is 6th March and for the ladies it starts on 13th April. Trials and the selection process will commence in earnest when we return from the Xmas break, but the first step is to make it known to the selectors that you are available to play by entering your name on the lists on the Bowls Notice Boards.

To enter your name on the ladies' list you must be female, a financial full bowling member of TWBC and affiliated with Women's Bowls NSW.

To enter your name on the men's list there is no gender restriction, but you must be a financial full bowling member of TBC and affiliated with the Royal NSW Bowls Association. (If you are not already a member of the Terrigal Bowling Club you need to join and become registered as a bowler with the Royal).

There are explanatory notices from both the Women's and Men's State Bowls Authorities on both Notice Boards which explain what events can be entered if female registered bowlers choose to remain registered with both organizations.

Once your name is on a pennant list you have given notice of your commitment to play – but that does not guarantee selection.

The selectors will consider many things, including your known and observed performance, any limitations which restrict where you can play and an assessment of team compatibility.
